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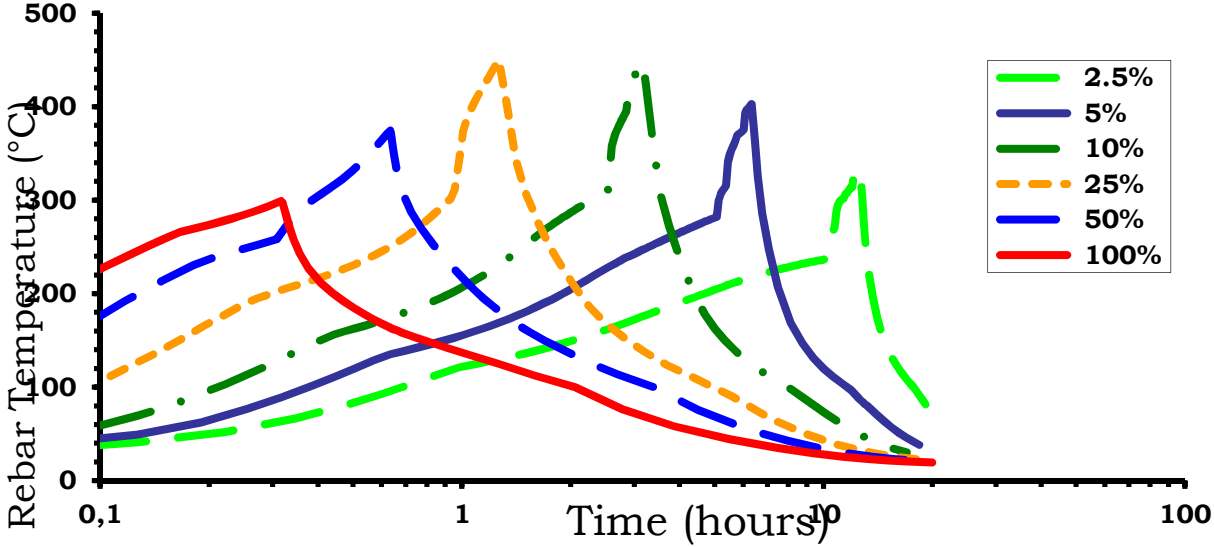
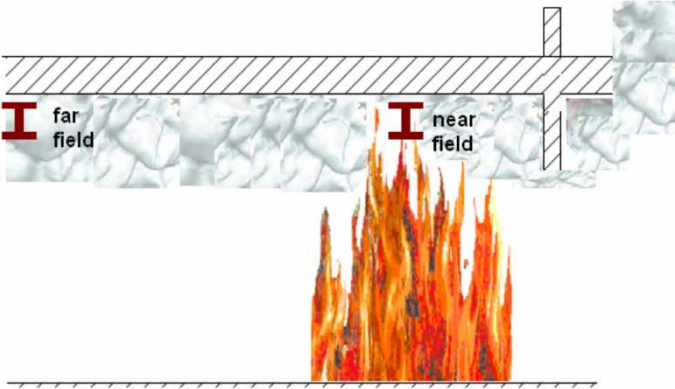
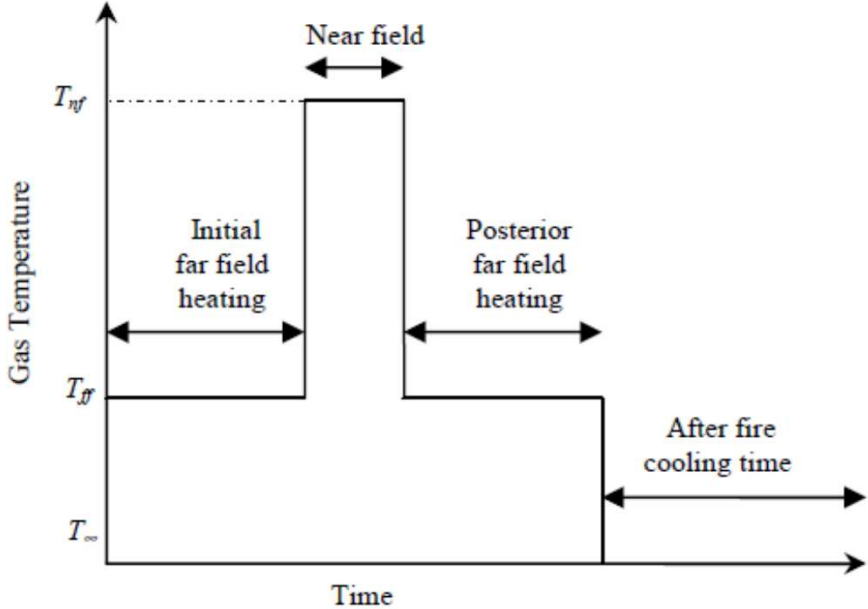
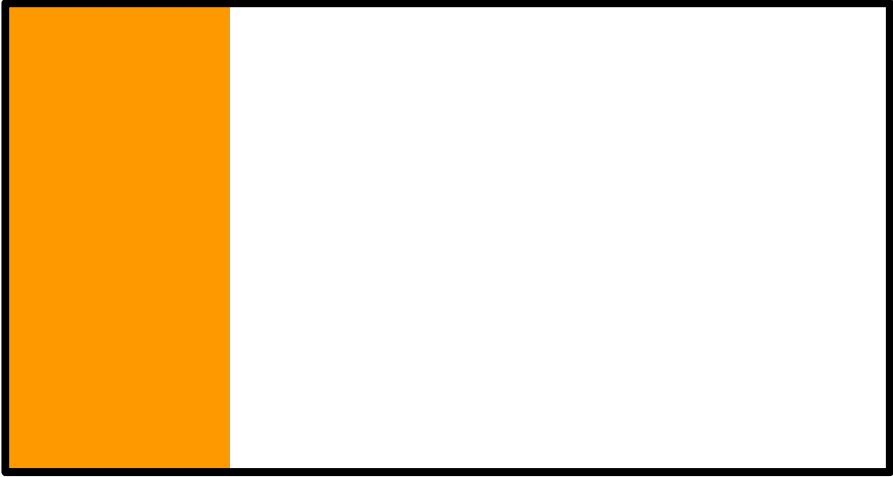


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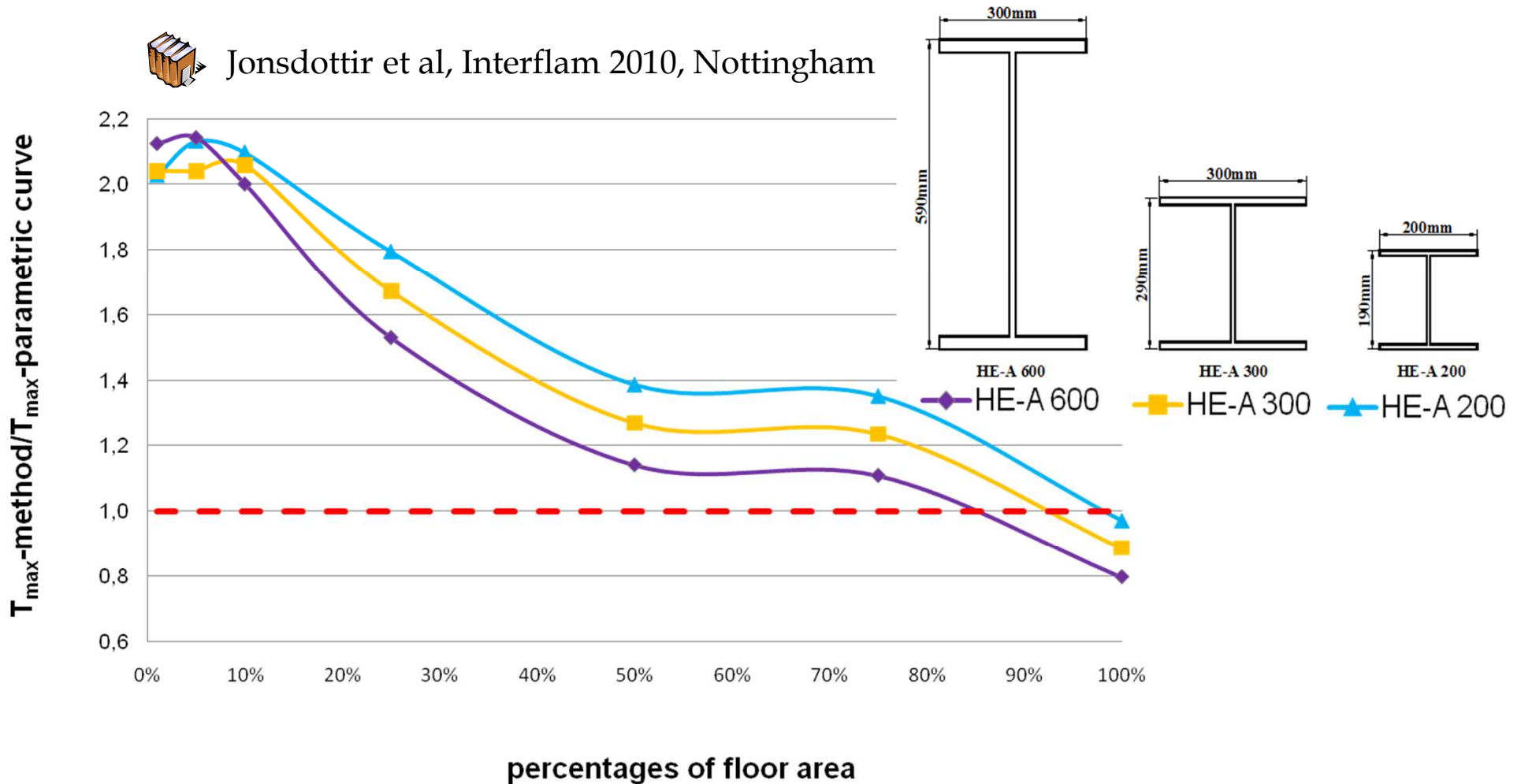




Family of Fires: Rebar Temperature



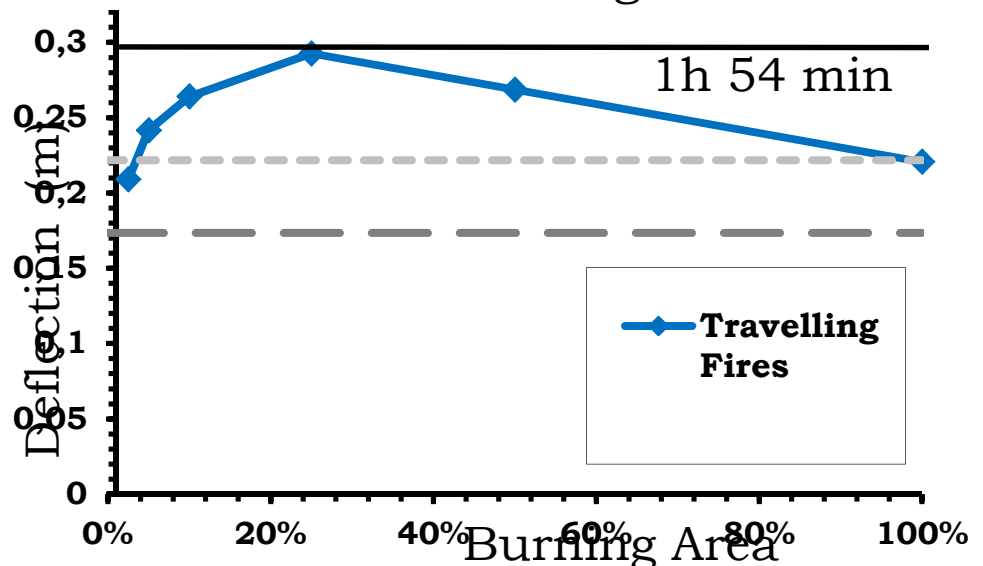
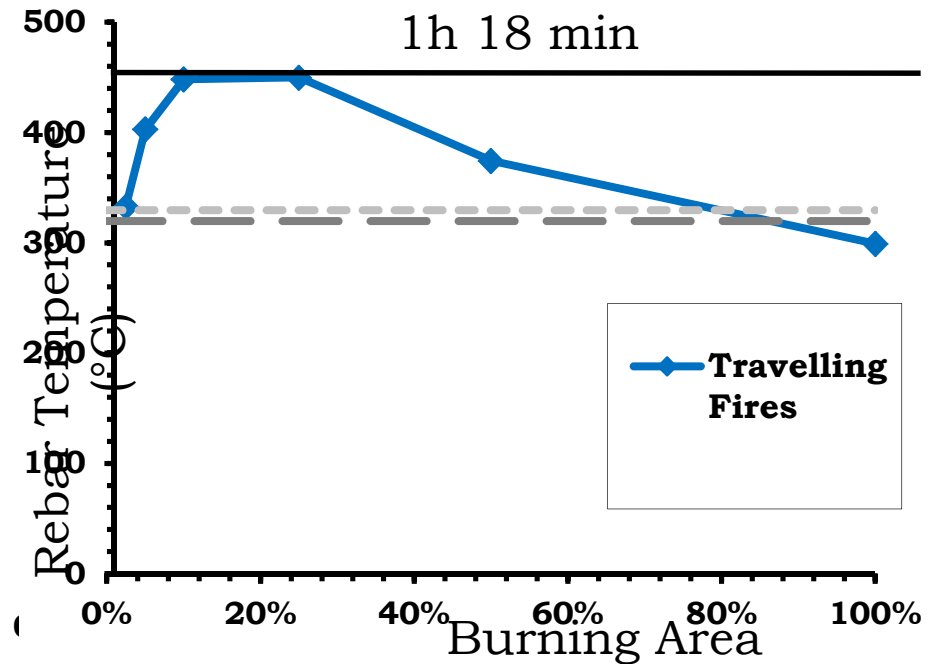
Insulated Steel: Parametric vs. Travelling fires



- Compared to parametric fire, 110% higher temperatures for a protected steel with 39 mm-gypsum

Concrete Frame: Parametric vs. Travelling fires

- In large compartments, a post flashover fire is not likely to occur
- Provides **range of possible** fire dynamics
- Travelling fires give more onerous conditions
