We would like to invite you to participate in our Action Training School:

“Fire Engineering Research - Key Issues for the Future”

which will take place between 11-14 April 2012 in Malta.

Depending on the budget available, we will be able to reimburse each Young Researcher by at least 650 €. We will be able to provide more information about the final budget available at the end of February.

The course will take place at the Victoria Hotel in Sliema, where we have a special arrangement which includes the use of its accommodation. It is assumed that Young Researchers will in general share twin rooms. Please register using the registration form attached, indicating a twin room (the hotel will understand!), by **15 February 2012**. Please return these directly to the hotel, with a copy to Kamila (kamila.horova@fsv.cvut.cz).

IMPORTANT!

The final two days of the Training School will be focussed on “brainstorming” sessions discussing your own research. You are expected to give a 20-minute Powerpoint presentation on your project, including any problems with it. This will be followed by a constructive discussion involving the whole group which will try to bring new ideas and helpful advice to your work. Obviously you are expected to participate freely in discussions on other researchers’ projects, so please come prepared to participate fully – this is not just a spectator event!

Please send a brief Abstract (< 1 page) of your project to Kamila (kamila.horova@fsv.cvut.cz). Only researchers who have returned both a Registration Form and provided an Abstract by 15 February 2012 will be reimbursed.
