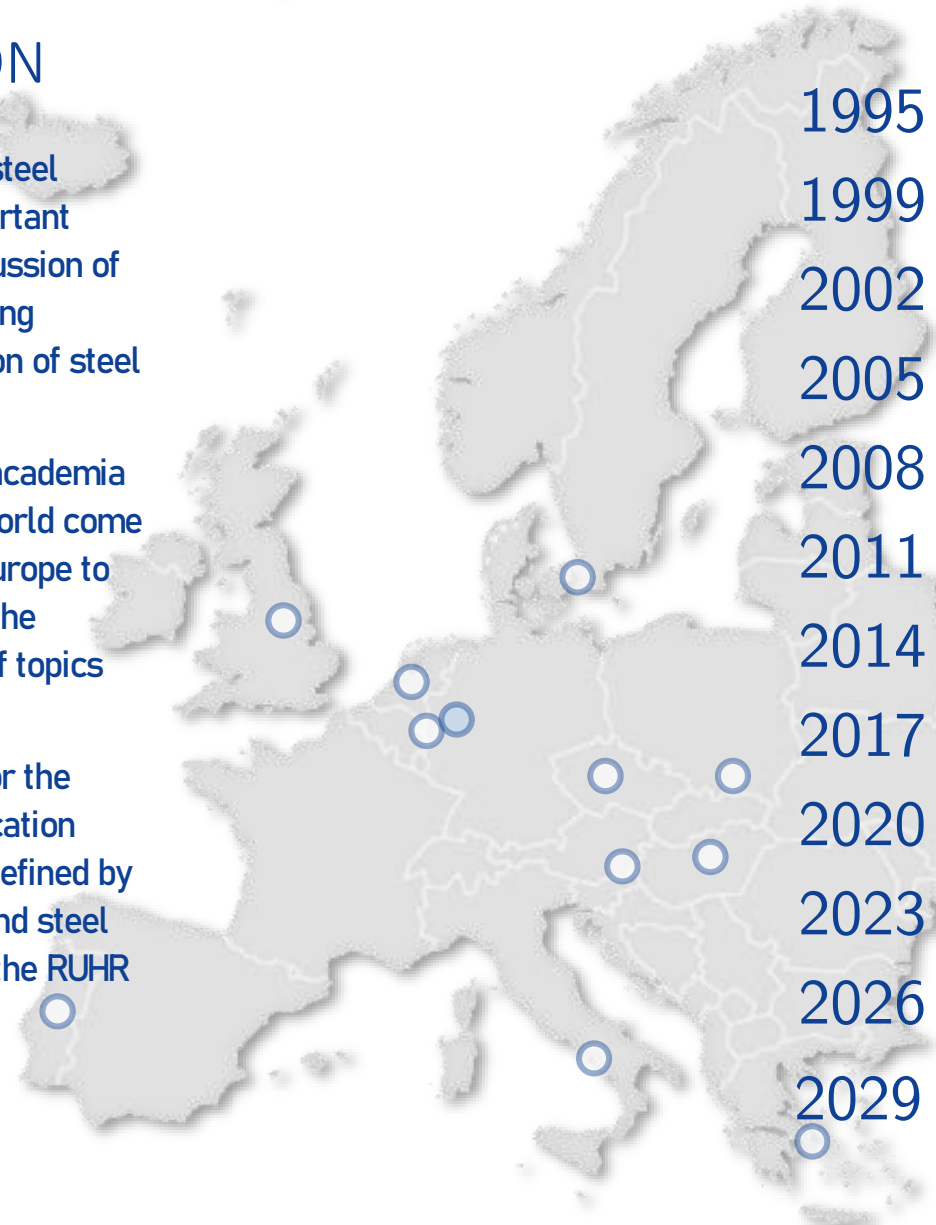

BOUT RUHR REGION

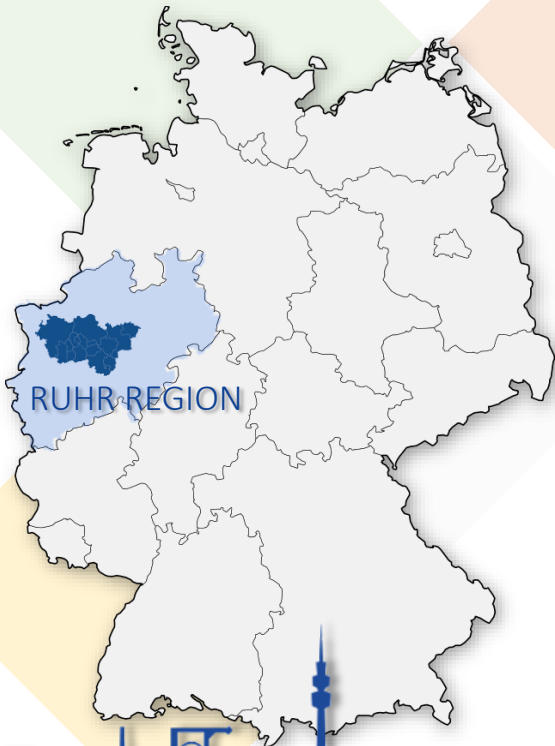
- **5.1 Million** people

Option A: Ruhr-University Bochum

Ruhr-University Bochum provides numerous (lecture) halls and seminar rooms of various sizes:



The AUDITORIUM MAXIMUM (Audimax) is the centre and the architectural highlight of the RUB. It offers space for up to 1.750 people and is equipped with a large stage and the well-known Klais organ.



RUB's CONVENTION CENTRE is a modern venue, which offers an attractive view over the green Ruhr Valley due to its location on the southern edge of the campus. The light-filled rooms are situated on one level and provide ideal meeting conditions for up to 800 people.



The BECKMANNS HOF, a protected monument, is located next to the Botanical Garden of the RUB. The historical building has seven meeting rooms, which combine modern facilities with the idyllic charm of the 300-year-old building.

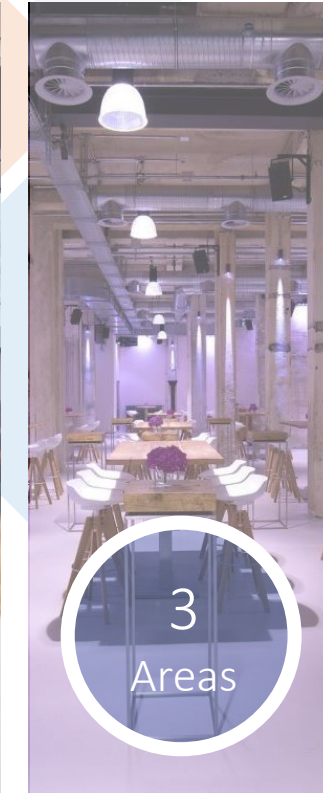
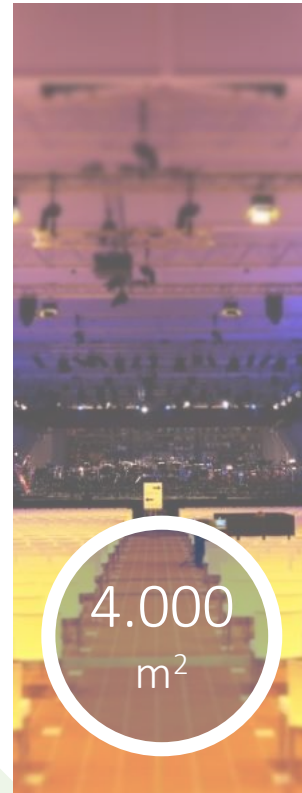


Option B: Zollverein

The Zollverein Coal Mine Industrial Complex is a former coal mine in the city of Essen, Germany, which was active from 1851 until 23rd December 1986.

The industrial complex was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List on 14th December 2001.

Once the largest and most powerful coal mine and coking plant, Zollverein is now a lively location for art, culture, industrial history and design and just the right place for the extraordinary.

STADIUM TOUR

The Veltins-Arena is an indoor football stadium in Gelsenkirchen. It opened on 13th August 2001, as the new home ground for Bundesliga club FC Schalke 04.

The stadium has a retractable pitch and it features a teflon-coated fiberglass canvas retractable roof, which spans the entire stadium. The roof is supported by a rectangular truss that is suspended above the field, which is in turn connected to the main building via 24 steel pylons. The center of the roof can be opened into two halves, allowing for an opened or covered stadium, depending on weather and event.

TIGER AND TURTLE

Tiger and Turtle is a large sculpture modeled on a roller coaster on the Heinrich Hildebrand Heights in Duisburg. The sculpture is made of galvanized steel and can be walked on in its entirety except for the loop. From a height of 48 meters, a visitor can look out over the surrounding landscape, such as the Krupp Mannesmann iron and steel works in Hüttenheim, Duisburg's city center, the Rhine and, in good visibility, as far as Düsseldorf (including the airport, the Rhine Tower and the illuminated pylons of the Rheinknie Bridge).

MINING MUSEUM

The German Mining Museum (or DBM) in Bochum is the largest mining museum in the world and a renowned research establishment for mining history.

Above-ground exhibitions, and a faithfully reconstructed show mine below the museum terrain give visitors insights into the world of mining. The main areas of research by the scientists are the History and Technology of Mining and the Documentation and Conservation of Cultural Artefacts.

BRIDGE TOUR

Slinky springs to fame (also Rehberger Bridge) is the name of a pedestrian bridge over the Rhine-Herne Canal in Oberhausen. The bridge, which is 406 m long in total, is a tension band bridge with two sheet metal bands made of high-strength steel that pass over slender 10 m high V-shaped steel supports and are anchored in the ground on each side by 4 vertical tie rods. The span between the supports is 66 m, the distance between the two supports of the V-shaped supports is 20 m each.

REGISTRATION FEE

There are two possible options for the registration fee depending on the venue: one lower-budget option with the venue at Ruhr-University Bochum and one higher-price option with the conference venue being the UNESCO world heritage Zollverein.

Both options are calculated based on the assumption of 500 participants.

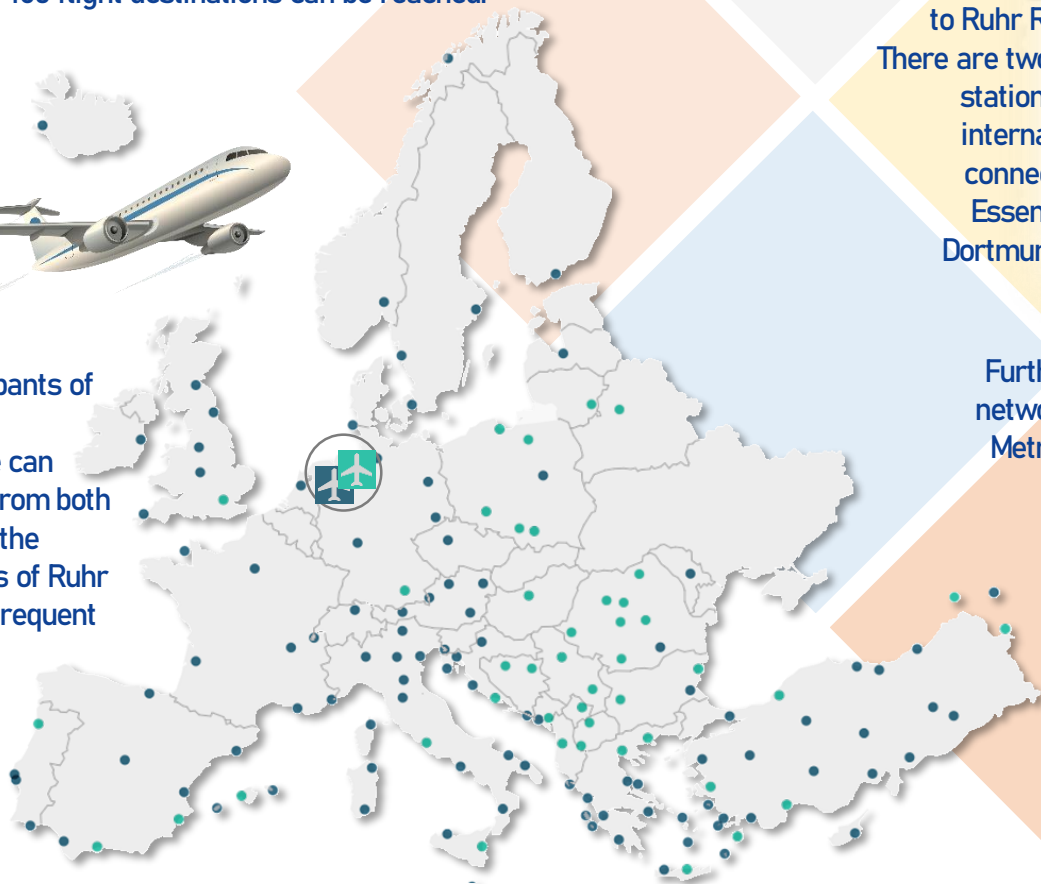
